New users will be prompted to "create account" via a button where the user will enter their name, @siu.edu email, and a password. Once signed up, the user will be redirected to the Members homepage where they can start using the resources/services/etc.

Note: To access AES materials, users must sign up for access using an siu.edu email address.

AES is the largest association for energy professionals in the world, representing over 135,000 energy professionals in every field and sector in academia, national laboratories, government, and industry in the U.S. and internationally. It provides regular and up-to-date non-partisan energy news, and analysis of energy-related information from around the world, including trends and factors affecting traditional and renewable energy resources, and the impact of current socio-political events on energy resources and supplies.

AES publishes a weekly email newsletter capturing current energy-related news and opportunities, (often including upcoming funding opportunities). It also tracks recent developments at DOE and other agencies and publishes periodic detailed reports of trends and developments in specific energy-related subjects that will be useful to students and faculty researchers interested in energy-related topics.
